

UNITED TO THE TOP

The 12th Annual Logistics and Transport Conference took place on November 5th in Belgrade

This year, the 12th Logistics & Transport Annual Conference set a new standard in the industry, gathering more than 500 participants from over 180 companies and 40+ sponsors.

This event was not just a business gathering – it was an opportunity to create new connections, exchange ideas, and enhance business opportunities, reaffirming the conference's status as a key event in the logistics and transport sector. The conference featured three simultaneous sessions and more than 30 inspiring lectures covering the latest trends and challenges in the industry.

This year, the 12th Logistics & Transport Conference was marked by exceptional innovation, and the two roundtables held in the sessions on Road Transport and Ports and Terminals enabled interactive discussions among industry experts. These roundtables provided deeper insights into the challenges and solutions shaping the future of transport and logistics.

THE OPENING SESSION

After the welcome coffee and the ceremonial opening by Marijana Jovin, **Nadežda Blagojeva** from **Stamh** had the honor of opening the session. Nadežda presented the application of automated systems in warehouses, emphasizing the key advantages of introducing automation into logistics.

After her presentation, Biljana Todorovic from Logistar explained in detail how automation is changing the fundamental processes of warehouse operations, contributing to greater accuracy, efficiency, and speed of operations. Stevica Carapic from MSC spoke about related topics of sustainability and digital transformation. Representatives from Element Logic and Wagen International, Joachim Kieninger and Milojko Lazarevic, presented the first automated warehouse for auto parts in Serbia, a project that brings greater efficiency and precision to warehouse management, opening new opportunities for the automotive sector. In the final part, Vladan Mišic from Port of Constanta presented the

strategic importance of this port in the context of the newly emerged geopolitical situation in the Black Sea, highlighting key infrastructure projects that will enable the port to maintain its leading position in regional transport. The session laid the foundation for further discussion about the challenges and opportunities that automation and digital transformation bring to logistics.


After the opening session, all attendees refreshed themselves at breakfast while visiting the booths at the 6th International LogExpo Fair, located in front of the conference rooms, which attracted exceptional interest. At this year's conference, 32 companies warmly welcomed visitors to their exhibition booths with promotional materials: Tenzor Group, LnConsult, CTP Invest, Logit, Mediterranean Shipping Company (MSC), Schoeller Allibert Services, Lift Truck Co, Vecar Viljuškari, Global Engineering Technologies, Priority Freight LTD, Logistar, Gebrüder Weiss, Stamh, Storage Systems, Cycle, Delta Transportni Sistem, Element Logic, Port of Constan a, SDT Group, Adriatic Gate Container Terminal, Nelt Co., M&M Militzer & Münch, TRANSLOG-Transport & logistix, Skladišna Logistika, Port of Adria, Luka Bar, Dexion, Omni-Pro, Jungheinrich, Hörmann Serbia, DP World, and Trasing. After individual meetings and friendly business conversations, participants continued the conference day in

smaller rooms designated for thematic sessions.

INTRALOGISTICS

At this year's conference, the session dedicated to intralogistics was opened by **Bojan Dobrota** from **LOGIT**, who spoke about the challenges in adopting new technologies and their real-world application in business. **Samo Bauman** from **Tenzor Group** presented Aura, a modular platform for optimizing warehouse management. **Dušan Petkovic** from **Lift Truck Co** highlighted the importance of safety solutions for protecting pedestrians in industrial environments. **Petar Vukosavljevic** from **Delta Transportni Sistem** analyzed global trends in the cold chain and local solutions. **Željko Ceovic** from **LNConsult** and **Dušan Djordjevic** from **Lilly Drogerie** discussed the transformation process of the logistics system at Lilly Drogerie, from the initial idea to implementation and practical application.

After the coffee break, **Tomislav Ivkovic** from **OMNI-PRO** presented advanced solutions for order picking, focusing on automation and optimization of warehouse processes. **Milan Balaban** and **David Mari** from **Schoeller Allibert** discussed solutions for returnable packaging, while **Nenad Kosanic** from **Storage Systems** presented modern technologies in intralogistics. **Stevan Stolic** from **ICM Electronics** spoke about automated robotic systems for palletizing, and the session



was closed by Prof. dr. **Slobodan Antic** from the **University of Belgrade**, who presented **TRACE SOLUTIONS** and the implementation of MES digital technologies in manufacturing.

The session provided insights into the latest technological innovations in intralogistics, emphasizing the importance of automation, safety, and sustainability in business.

ROAD TRANSPORT

The session dedicated to road transport this year brought together experts and innovators from the logistics field, who discussed contemporary challenges and solutions for efficient, sustainable, and safe road transport management. The session was opened by Dane Ajdukovic from SDT **Group**, who spoke about the renting of commercial vehicles and the electric future of transport. Kristina Dokic from Priority Freight LTD presented Air Cargo Transport as a key element in time-critical logistics operations. Nadi Kanaan and Aleksandar Živulovic from Negometal discussed optimizing profitability on the road. Aleksandar Jovanovic from Cycle spoke about eCommerce and Fulfillment end-to-end solutions that enable complete digitalization of logistics processes in online retail. Nikola Jevtic from Enpeks raised the guestion "How can we embrace digitalization while preserving our values?" and explained how to build lasting relationships with customers, while Ana Tucakovic explained how digitalization is transforming the transport of dangerous goods and its key benefits for the industry.

After the coffee break, lawyer Siniša Pješcic spoke about the impact of travel reporting in the EU on road transport, considering the legal aspects and potential legislative changes that could affect goods transport within the European Union. Srdjan Jovanovic and Aleksa Milovanovic from BexExpress presented Sustainable Logistics and the implementation of BEX's Green Agenda. Sara Ilic from Logistika.biz highlighted the impact of social media on the logistics and transport industry, emphasizing how digital marketing can help promote services and build a brand.

To conclude, a roundtable was held on the topic "Towards sustainable transport by optimizing transport operations." The participants were Nebojša Gvozdenovic, owner and founder of Infora Research Group, Miloš Vojinovic, director of Mobile Solutions, and Ivan Blagojevic, sales manager at Frotcom Serbia.

The discussion focused on reducing CO₂ emissions, better capacity utilization, and the role of technologies in transport optimization. Nebojša Gvozdenovic presented route optimization software, Ivan Blagojevic presented case studies, and Miloš Vojinovic spoke about routing and fleet management.

It was concluded that digital solutions and the transition to electric vehicles represent key steps toward more

sustainable transport, while investment in infrastructure and strategic partnerships enable a more efficient and environmentally friendly system.

This session provided insights into key innovations and strategies shaping the future of road transport, with a focus on efficiency, digitalization, sustainability, and safety in logistics operations.

PORTS AND TERMINALS

The session dedicated to ports and terminals brought together experts and practitioners from the logistics industry, who discussed key challenges and innovations in this field.

The session was opened by Branislav Mamic from the Vojvodina Chamber of Commerce, who spoke about the role of the chamber in the logistics and transport industry. Miroslav Antolovic from Konecranes and Marko Karamarkovic from Vecar Viljuškari presented Konecranes Lift Trucks, designed to meet the specific needs of the industry. Vuk Mijanovic from Nelt Co. spoke about the role of dry port terminals in the end-to-end supply chain. Lawyer Siniša Pjescic discussed the impact of travel reporting in the EU on water transport, considering the legal aspects of transport via internal and international waterways.

Sedat Kara from Port of Adria presented Port of Adria Bar, which serves as a strategic maritime terminal for trade between the Balkans and the rest of the world. Iva Roman from Adriatic Gate Container Terminal spoke about the Port of Rijeka as Serbia's gateway to the Adriatic Sea, highlighting the logistical advantages of this terminal in international trade. Kristina Dokic from Priority Freight LTD, who had already impressed the audience in the road transport session, continued her presentation on ports and terminals, providing further insights into logistical challenges and solutions.

To conclude, a roundtable was held on the topic "Intermodality – the Key to Sustainable Transport Solutions." The moderator of the discussion was Branislav Mamic, and the participants included: Sanja Djurišic, the president of the ports and terminals group at the Serbia Chamber of Commerce, Ivan Milicevic, development and operations manager for intermodal transport at **Nelt Group**, and Slavoljub Jevtic, the president of Transport and Logistics Association. The discussion covered key topics such as the role of intermodal operators in transport sustainability, challenges in using terminals for dangerous goods, the importance of river ports for intermodal transport in Serbia, and the advantages of linking with ports for import-export products. The importance of digital transformation in optimizing operations and the role of strategic partnerships in implementing sustainable transport solutions were also

This session provided valuable insights into the development of key infrastructural connections between markets, with a focus on innovations in intermodal solutions, sustainability, and the integration of new technologies in transport and logistics.



In addition to the discussions, the conference also included a giveaway that generated a lot of excitement among the attendees. Jungheinrich made one lucky winner's day by presenting them with an AME 15 electric pallet truck. This modern device, now part of daily logistics operations, was handed over to Miroslav Ristic from Hörmann Serbia. The lucky winner was drawn by Zlatan Lesjak, and the prize caused great excitement among the participants. Congratulations to Miroslav Ristic and many thanks to Jungheinrich for this gift, which makes daily logistics operations easier!

Additionally, this year we exceeded last year's success once again, securing more than 150 B2B meetings that brought together key players in the logistics and transport industry.

After a series of inspiring presentations, visiting the Logexpo, enjoying socializing and food, we successfully concluded another conference day, full of new knowledge, business opportunities, and unforgettable moments. This day was dedicated to networking, learning, and creating new connections among professionals from all sectors of logistics.
